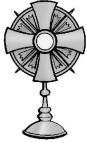

They invade your home through the telephone, computer, and the mail; advertise in well-known newspapers and magazines; and come to your door. They're well mannered, friendly, and helpful—at first. Most people think they're too smart to fall for a scam. But con artists rob all kinds of people—from investment counselors and doctors to teenagers and senior citizens—of billions of dollars every year. Cons, scams, and frauds disproportionately victimize seniors with false promises of miracle cures, financial security, and luxury prizes. One easy rule to remember: **If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is.**

If you think someone has tried to con you, report the incident to the police, your city or state consumer protection office or call the National Fraud Information Center at 800-876-7060.

Don't be embarrassed. Some very, very astute people have been taken in by these pros!
