FAITH FORMATION/RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We are now accepting registration for the 2010-2011 school year. Current students have already received re-registration information. Parents of students who are new to our program can find registration information and forms at the entrances of our Cluster parishes. If you have a child in a public school in Grades 1 through 8, please pick up information to register them for classes. Faith Formation/Religious Education classes will begin in September.

Important information regarding sacramental preparation:

- Preparation for the sacrament of Reconciliation is offered to students who are in their 2nd year of Faith Formation classes.
- Preparation for the sacrament of Holy Communion is offered to students who are in their 3rd consecutive year of Faith Formation classes.
- Confirmation preparation is a 3-year process. Students preparing to receive the sacrament of Confirmation must attend class for 3 consecutive years, beginning in the 6th Grade.

Stewardship—A Way of Life

Today we celebrate the feast of the Holy Trinity—one God in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Many saints, teachers and theologians have tried to describe the Holy Trinity. The scriptures contain many references to the *relationship* of the three—God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Saint Paul calls us the Body of Christ and says that we, as believers, are in *relationship* with God—equally called, equally chosen, equally loved—yet with different gifts, different abilities, different callings in life. The only thing that God asks is our love in return, and that we use what God has given us. It's that simple.
