

*From the Pastor's Desk***"I AM WITH YOU ALWAYS"**

(Matthew 28:20)

Last Sunday we celebrated the Feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus and this past Friday the Feast of the Sacred Heart. Both Feasts contain a mystery — a wonderful expression of the overwhelming love Jesus has for us. The heart is a symbol of His love; the Eucharist is the reality of that love. Jesus fulfills His promise: He would be with us always because He loves us this much!

Pope John Paul II in his Apostolic Letter, "Stay With Us Lord" wrote these words for our reflection:

"All the various dimensions of the Eucharist come together in one aspect which more than any other makes a demand on our faith: the mystery of the "real" presence. With the entire tradition of the Church, we believe that Jesus is truly present under the Eucharistic species. This presence is called "real" not in an exclusive way, as if to suggest that other forms of Christ's presence are not real, but real *par excellence*, because Christ thereby becomes substantially present, whole and entire, in the reality of His body and blood. Faith demands that we approach the Eucharist fully aware that we are approaching Christ himself. It is precisely His presence which gives the other aspects of the Eucharist — as meal, as memorial of the Pascal Mystery, as eschatological anticipation — a significance which goes far beyond mere symbolism. The Eucharist is a mystery of presence, the perfect fulfillment of Jesus' promise to remain with us until the end of the world."

Thank you, Jesus, for your love made real in your Eucharist Presence!

In today's Gospel, Luke tells us about a Pharisee who invites Jesus to his house for a meal. Because only prostitutes went about with unbound hair, she is condemned by Jesus' Pharisee friend as being a sinner. Sinfulness was thought to cause illness. No one knows her actual condition, but Jesus is aware that she knows her own brokenness and has complete faith in God to make her whole. Like Jesus, reach out to those who are ill, lonely or addicted, and pray that God will give the healing they need.

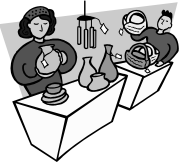
