

*From the Pastor's Desk***SUMMER HELP NEEDED!**

The fiscal year for our parish runs from July 1 and to the following June 30. Expect a parish financial report soon after this year's books are closed. We are trying to be good stewards of your donations, however, like so many families today, it is becoming extremely difficult to meet the expenses.

We are in the midst of tough financial times. Our Sunday collections have fallen to an all time low. Yet, repairs are necessary to maintain our aging and well-used facilities in order to prevent further deterioration. Among these replacements scheduled for this summer (and their price tag) are:

- Tuck pointing the outside school wall facing Lincoln Avenue: \$45,918.00
- Replacement of the "bus" garage and Auditorium roofs: \$10,768.00
- Replacement of the stage door on 119th Street: \$3,995.00
- Replacement of the floor covering for the Computer Room #209: \$3,665.00
- Replacement of five more of the original Rectory windows: \$5,148

Our Sunday collections cannot cover the ordinary expenses plus these costs. If at all possible, please consider putting a little extra in your envelope. Otherwise we have to dip into the savings for \$70,000.00 to meet the above expenses.

Thank you for your continuing support in the past and for going beyond to give extra!

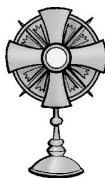

**IMMIGRATION REFORM
 LEARNING FACTS...BUSTING MYTHS**

"It is first important to remind ourselves that most of the laws that define our system today did not even exist before the 20th century. Moreover, they have been amended and changed over time in order to seek this difficult balance.

What we are left with today, however, is a bureaucracy that fails to respond to current economic and social realities. Now with an estimated 12 million people residing in our country without documentation, we are facing a complete breakdown of the rule and order. We bishops, along with many others, believe that this is another one of those times when we must reconsider how to bring things back on track.

We are in this predicament because the sad truth is that there are few visas available for immigrants to actually migrate here legally. Each year, Congress allocated only 5,000 permanent visas for "unskilled workers," even through hundreds of thousands of undocumented immigrants are finding jobs in this category. In addition, the spouses, children and other immediate relatives of many of those who did enter legally end up having to wait years to be reunited with their loved ones. For example, a man from Mexico who whole be fortunate enough to get a permanent employment visa to work here would still have to wait about four years before his wife and children could join him. For a Filipino to have his brother or sister come join him, it would take 22 years!" (taken from letter by the Most Reverend Dennis M.
